Cheryl Carlile and Jan Duffy reviewed the financial records for the year ended June 30, 2022 and found no errors. The Treasurer's report will be placed on file for Chapter inspection.

Committee Reports

Membership: The Chapter has 16 members. The membership committee of Kate Mulder (chair), Jan Duffy, Cindy Sippel and Karen Jacobson has met twice via Zoom prior to the meeting. The committee would like to sponsor a membership drive event on the September and November meeting dates. The September meeting would include inviting people through Linked In, Facebook, and local groups like the Ames Young Professionals and the ISU Collegiate Women in Business Group. Members would also be encouraged to reach out to any people they know in the community. Jan Duffy moved, and Karen Jacobson seconded, that the budget include \$1,000 to pay for this meeting. The motion passed.

The committee is also proposing that anyone who joins through this campaign and is an active member for two years will get their chapter dues for those two years refunded.
